

Community Engagement Policy


Objective: The objective of this Policy is to provide guidance for the application and management of community engagement within the wider Lake Turkana Wind Power Ltd (LTWP) Project area, with a focus on those communities that will be directly affected by development activities.

LTWP is committed to:

- Treating our neighbours with respect, understanding and dignity, and aiming to ensure that our Project (during development, construction, operations and decommission) neither prejudice nor infringe on their rights or interests, whether they are legally binding or of a cultural or traditional common ownership perspective;
- Respecting community governance and endeavouring to implement the Project in a manner such that there are no significant objections to initiating any significant development that may have a substantial negative impact on their interests;
- Recognising that local communities should be informed of the potential impacts, risks, and benefits that may result from our Project;
- Respecting local communities' rights to determine their needs and priorities in addition to their freedom to articulate their thoughts, concerns and expectations about our Project;
- Consulting stakeholders on those aspects of our Project that may have a direct bearing on their lives or livelihoods;
- Ensuring that our Project neither harm nor threaten the sustainability of local communities;
- Contributing positively to the social and economic sustainability of communities affected by our Project;
- Recognising that some communities may require special assistance to enable them to take up any opportunities that we may seek to provide;
- Recognising that peoples' interests in property and natural resources may sometimes derive from tradition, common ownership and spiritual association in addition to legal title;
- Recognising the importance of the ties many peoples have with the lands they traditionally occupy and the natural resources they use;
- Providing Project affected persons who are directly affected with fair and adequate compensation for any losses they may incur for which we are legally liable;
- Making relevant Project information accessible in a timely manner and in a language and format understandable to the groups being consulted; and
- Undertaking public consultation and disclosure procedures in an ongoing, transparent, and equitable manner in accordance with LTWP's Community Engagement Plan.

The maintenance, revision and distribution of this Policy is the responsibility of LTWP.
