Re: EXTENSION of the term of the Environmental Impact Assessment Procedure for an additional term of 60 days.

In response to your communications and CDs submitted at Citizenship Contact Space (ECC, Spanish acronym) of this Federal Regional Office for the Department of Environment and Natural Resources in the State of Tamaulipas, hereinafter the **Regional Office**, through which Mr. Luis Fernando Villareal Ibarra, hereinafter the **Petitioner**, submits documents regarding clarifications, rectifications or extensions required for the Environmental Impact Statement, Special Modality (EIS-S) of the project called “Tres Mesas Wind Farm”, intended to be located at the municipality of Llera, Tamaulipas, hereinafter the **Project**.

On this regard, due to the complexity and dimensions of the Project, as well as the documents recently delivered to this **Regional Office**, as referred to in the previous paragraph, in order to issue the corresponding and duly grounded resolution, we need to have more time to continue assessing the Project in terms of environmental impact. Therefore, besides resources subject to use or impact, the possible effect of the works and activities of the Project in the ecosystem(s) considering all elements composing it should also be assessed; as well as the use of natural resources respecting the functional integrity and carrying capacities of the ecosystems said resources are a part of, for indefinite terms.

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Based on the aforementioned and grounded on section 35 Bis, last paragraph, of the General Law of Biological Balance and Environmental Protection, as well as 46, first paragraph, fraction II, and second, of the Regulations of the General Law of Biological Balance and Environmental Protection in Environmental Impact Assessment matters, this **Regional Office EXTENDS for up to sixty additional days the term to assess the Project.**

Notify this resolution to the **Petitioner** or to whoever has been expressly indicated for said purpose, by any of the means set forth in section 35 of the Federal Law of Administrative Procedure and in accordance thereof.
